Free Tutorial Classes for Junior and Senior High School Students

We organised free tutorial classes for students (from May to July 2020) whom their education was cut-short due to Covid-19 and could not afford private tuition.

Tutorial classes were specifically for students who were preparing towards their Junior and Senior West African Examination.

Tutorial classes were in form of virtual learning which were uploaded on our YouTube Channel – https://youtube.com/c/vickiesfoundation

We uploaded 97 tutorial videos which ranges through 13 subjects and reached out to 689 students in Nigeria, Ghana, Sierra Leone, Gambia, and Côte d'Ivoire.

We published our Mathematics article in September 2020.


The Mathematics document showed

Exposure to Scholarship Opportunities


We started releasing global Scholarship updates to our audience in September 2020.
